Two years ago, they celebrated their Sesquicentennial as a Church. (That's 150 years as stated in Paul's letter to the Thesaurians) The Rev. Paul Strickert has served as their Pastor since the year 2000. In that time, he has established a strong bond not only within the congregation but the community as a whole. Worshipping with these folk one clearly gets a sense that they are a loving congregation who extend grace to one another in abundance. Poynette is a small but mighty place.
