

Boundary Training Policy

From the *Book of Order*, adopted this year: (Underlined words are new requirements)
All councils shall adopt and implement **the following policies: a sexual misconduct policy, a harassment policy, a child and youth protection policy, and an antiracism policy. Each council's policy shall include requirements for boundary training which includes the topic of sexual misconduct, and child sexual abuse prevention training for its members at least every thirty-six months.** (G-3.0106)

Here is a sample statement to be inserted in your Sexual misconduct or child and youth protection policy:

The session of _____ will participate in boundary training which includes the topic of sexual misconduct, and child sexual abuse prevention training for its members at least every thirty-six months. This training may be in person or online.
