JOHN KNOX PRESBYTERY Pulpit Supply List Policy

- 1. Pulpit Supply is intended as a Sunday by Sunday relationship. If the church is intending to invite the same supply preacher for more than 2 weeks in any given month, Presbytery approval is required through the COM. If this situation occurs because of an emergency or time constraints, COM must be informed.
- 2. Persons eligible to be placed on the Pulpit Supply list include:
 - A. Presbyterian Teaching Elders who are members in good standing of the John Knox Presbytery are eligible to be placed on the list, or those honorably retired from the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) and living within our bounds.
 - B. Non-clergy and non-Presbyterians requesting to be placed on the Pulpit Supply must complete the application below.
