This week we lift up for your consideration First Presbyterian Church of Cambria, WI and their Pastor the Rev. Kristin Frederich. First Presbyterian is a congregation of just over 150 members in a community North and slightly West of Madison in the heart of Region 5. Last year the congregation celebrated 160 years of mission and ministry from 1859 to 2019. They have also enjoyed a healthy and vibrant ministry with Pastor Kristin for 16 years. FPC serves their community in many traditional ways, supporting needs such as Al-Anon, 4-H, and the local food pantry, but their biggest challenge as a community happened on May 31, 2017. That night the Didion Milling Facility suffered an explosion due to dust build up. The blast killed 5 workers and injured 14 others. FPC was instrumental in providing space for emergency responders, counselors & assistance for victims and residents, and hospitality to a grieving and shocked population. FPC and Pastor Kristin are a fine example of a congregation serving their members, friends, and neighbors in the midst of all their needs. Please keep these good folk in your prayers.
